El presente perfecto continuo permite mostrar que una acción comenzó en el pasado y continúa en el presente. “Por cinco minutos,” “por dos semanas,” y “desde el martes” son algunas expresiones de duración que podemos usar:

Keywords:

- For: (por) Se utiliza para referirse a una cantidad de tiempo específica
For two weeks / por 2 semanas.
- Since: (Desde) Se utiliza para marcar el inicio de un evento o acción.
